To WA Rally Car Owners (gravel & tarmac)

Further to our previous advice (09 Oct) on the Dedicated Rally Car (DRC) Program, the special series DRC licence plates are nearing completion with the DoT. An opportunity has arisen where we are able to increase the quantity of DRC plates available in the series with the following one and two digit numbers now being available, in addition to the original three digit series: 01 to 09, and 1 to 99. For example it is possible to have 007, 07, and 7 on three separate DRC plates.



Above plate examples are indicative of layout only and not to scale.

Note that the lettering does not change only the numbers. The plates will cost \$140 for the pair as previously advised, and once ready for production those who have registered an interest will be advised of the next steps in the process. Plate applications can be made at any time subsequent to the initial issue of plates at the same price.
