In one of our earlier updates, we advised that CAMS were introducing a change to the licensing structure for all Officials. These changes have been approved and a simpler solution is now in place. Under the new structure, there are six levels of licensing.

- Trainee
- General Official
- Club Chief
- Bronze (renamed from Grade 3)
- Silver (renamed from Grade 2)
- Gold (renamed from Grade 1)
