## ELECTION 2008

As you will know, Premier Carpenter has called a State Election on Saturday 6th September. QTW Organisers have been in contact with the AEC to determine the best way to manage how all Competitors, Officials and Volunteers will be able to vote.

AEC have recommended the following options:

1. Go online at [www.waec.wa.gov.au](http://www.waec.wa.gov.au) and apply for a postal vote and they will post out the forms;
2. Visit your local Post office and they will provide you with a postal vote application form; or
3. Visit any AEC office or court house and do an early vote (locations of the AEC offices are found on their website).

Individuals can also vote at the Bindoon Hall at the Bindoon Service Park during the service break.

There will be additional AEC staff at the locations along the course to assist with the expected extra people, officials and competitors.
