



QUIT Targa West set to hit the streets of Perth like never before

QUIT Targa West is set to hit the streets of Perth in a way never seen in the events six year history, with a Grand Finale to be held in the CBD.

The 3.23 kilometer Killarnée City of Perth Super Stage will be run as the final three stages of the event and with the outright winners often still to be determined at this point the action for spectators is set to be fantastic.

Perth Lord Mayor Lisa Scaffidi says: “This will be a great attraction for the city, given the high level of public interest in motorsport in this State.

Aside from the competitive stages the Killarnée City of Perth Super Stage will also include special displays from local car clubs, special interest vehicles, the Shannons Super Rig, the 96fm live team and even a professional paintball competition.

“The Killarnée City of Perth Super Stage is going to be a fitting conclusion to what is set to be one of the best years in the events history,” QUIT Targa West Event Director Bob Schrader said.
