

2011 QUIT Targa West opens with the Go Gear Racing Services Prologue at Whiteman Park. This venue provides spectators the opportunity to not only view the Prologue but also see Special Stages 1 and 2 of the rally.

Whiteman Park offers a very pleasant and relaxing atmosphere. The rally cars will be assembled in front of the Motor Museum by 12.30pm with Prologue set to commence at 1.30pm. This will give spectators time to take a close look at all the rally cars on display and talk to the competitors. During this time the competitors and spectators can enjoy lunch at the Park Café before the competition begins. Prologue will be run twice followed by Special Stages 1 & 2.

The Park tram will be running throughout the day to take spectators to and from the Village Centre and Mussel Pool where you will find the start line for the rally stages.

Entry to the Park and viewing the rally action is free of charge. Come and be a part of the first day of QUIT Targa West and take the time to enjoy Whiteman Park and all it has to offer.

The Motor Museum is well worth a look, so make sure you allow time to view the 130 vehicles on display.

If you arrive by 11.30am you will hear the rally cars doing a reconnaissance of the stage while you familiarise yourself with Whiteman Park.
