Forrest Place in the heart of the City of Perth is the place to be on Friday morning the 26th August for the official start for QUIT Targa West 2011. Cars will assemble from 7.30am and at 9.00am the Lord Mayor of the City of Perth will wave off the first of the rally cars. Come and enjoy the colour and excitement of the rally as the drivers prepare to head off from the city to the RAC Driver Training Centre for Special Stage 3.

After the cars complete Special Stage 4 in the John Forrest National Park they move on to the Zig Zag Special Stage in Kalamunda. This Stage is very popular with spectators and a real challenge for the drivers. There is **NO PARKING** at or near the Zig Zag so catch the Shuttle Bus from the designated **FREE** parking area at Jorgensen Park off Mundaring Weir Rd. (See details on map below) The Shuttle Bus will be running a regular service throughout the day.

Mundaring Weir Road is the longest Special Stage for the day and the Mundaring Weir Hotel is a great viewing location to catch the cars as they duck and weave in and out of Hall Road past the hotel.

The Kalamunda town site becomes the centre of the rally for the day, with the main street closed to traffic and the cars coming in and out to service the vehicles while the competitors and crews take a well deserved lunch break. Once all the Special Stages are completed the cars return to the Ascot Service Park, then into Northbridge for the evening.

James and Lake Streets in Northbridge will be closed to traffic for all the cars to go on display for the Show 'n' Shine from 6.00pm to 9.30pm. This provides the opportunity to take a close look at the rally cars, and is sure to please the keen photographer. Rally action and images will light up the big screen in the Piazza on the corner of James and Lake Streets.
