



QUIT Targa West is more than just a series of rally stages. Each day provides a major attraction to enable corporate VIP's, spectators and media to get up close to the cars and drivers, and experience much more than just watching the cars in action. With the quality of vehicles entered, it will be a spectacle whether they are competing or on display.

Thursday 25th August

Rally Prologue: Whiteman Park – 1.30pm to 5.30pm

Used to determine the starting order of the event, the prologue is a great opportunity to see the cars and teams in action for the first time, commencing in the afternoon at 1.30pm at Whiteman Park, off Lord Street, West Swan. Each car will do the Prologue twice over a 3.75km course from Mussel Pool to Beechboro Road. The rally will then start with another two runs for SS1 & SS2. There is plenty to do at Whiteman Park from the Motor or Tractor Museums, Café, Art & Crafts stores or stroll in the Whiteman Park Village.

Friday 26th August

Rally Start: Forrest Place - 7.30am to 10.00am

The ceremonial start will be in Forrest Place and Murray Street Mall. With cars gathering from 7.30am and the first car being waved away by the Lord Mayor at 9.00am. Early morning commuters are treated to a once a year spectacular display of cars assembled in the City.

Zig Zag Scenic Drive – 10.50am to 11.50am and 1.20pm to 2.20pm

This iconic road on the Kalamunda escarpment attracts plenty of interest, a one way road reversed. It's advisable to arrive early before the action starts. Please note there is NO PARKING at the Zig Zag, catch the Shuttle Bus from Jorgenson Park off Mundaring Weir Road (Designated Targa West Spectator Parking Area).

Kalamunda Lunch Stop – 11.00am to 3.30pm

The crews stop for a lunch break in Haynes Street, the main street. This is an easy place to view the cars and enjoy the cafés. The first car will arrive just after 11.00am. For the next 4 hours there will be cars arriving and leaving as they come in from the Zig Zag and leave for the Kalamunda Special Stage along Mundaring Weir Road. Each car will be in Haynes Street on two occasions for at least 40 minutes each time.

Northbridge – 6.00pm to 9.30pm

From 6.00pm to 9.30pm James and Lake Streets in Northbridge will be closed as the cars stage a static Show-n-Shine along the café strip. It will be a great opportunity to view the colourful spectacle and variety of the many different cars on display.

Saturday 27th / Sunday 28th August

The Service Park will be in Toodyay on both days with action between 9.45am and 2.30pm on the Saturday and 8.30am and 1.00pm on the Sunday. The Toodyay Service Park on Saturday is in the Showgrounds, just across the river. On Sunday it moves into the main street. Come along and enjoy the atmosphere and taste local cuisine in the various cafés.

Sunday 28th August

Killarnée City of Perth Super Stage

The Grand Finale will have plenty of action prior to the start of the final stages of the rally commencing at 2.00pm. There will be a 96fm Live Broadcast, a paintball competition and food and drinks will be available. The Classic Race Car Sprints and Car Display will ensure there is something happening all the time from 11.00am to 4.00pm promising a great way to finish one of WA's major motorsport events.

Rally Finish 3.45pm

The Champagne Finish and Presentations will be under the Arch on Plain Street from 3.45pm onwards. With champagne and medallions being presented as the cars arrive, this is a fabulous way to enjoy the climax of the 2011 QUIT Targa West.

Sunday Night Gala Presentation Dinner

To celebrate the conclusion of the rally a Gala Presentation Dinner is held at the Burswood Entertainment Complex in the Grand Ballroom Two. This function is a '5-star night' for competitors, sponsors, invited guests and officials. The night will include the first showing of the TV highlights recorded over the four days of rally action.
