<p>ADVANCE 1</p> <p>www.targawest.com.au</p> <p>NORTHSIDE NISSAN</p>	<p>ADVANCE CARS 1 & 2</p> <p>This vehicle assists the Officials in the setup of the stage. It is also available to assist residents to enter or leave their properties after the roads are closed and before the competition starts. It traverses the course between 60 and 30 minutes before the first competitor.</p>
<p>000A</p> <p>www.targawest.com.au</p> <p>NORTHSIDE NISSAN</p>	<p>CAR 000 A & B</p> <p>This vehicle checks the stage is set up correctly and spectators are in safe areas. It passes approximately 30 minutes before the first competitor.</p>
<p>00</p> <p>www.targawest.com.au</p> <p>NORTHSIDE NISSAN</p>	<p>CAR 00</p> <p>This vehicle checks the stage is secure and reports to Rally Command that the Challenge and Competition Cars can begin. It passes approximately 15 minutes before the first competitor.</p>
<p>0A</p> <p>www.targawest.com.au</p> <p>NORTHSIDE NISSAN</p>	<p>CAR 0A</p> <p>This vehicle warns the spectators and residents that the Challenge Cars are about to start. It passes approximately 5 minutes before the first Challenge Car and conducts another safety check to ensure residents and spectators are in a safe place.</p>
<p>1C</p> <p>www.targawest.com.au</p> <p>NORTHSIDE NISSAN</p>	<p>CHALLENGE CATEGORY CARS</p> <p>Challenge Cars have reduced safety requirements and are speed limited. They start at 30 second intervals with the slowest first and fastest last.</p>
<p>0B</p> <p>www.targawest.com.au</p> <p>NORTHSIDE NISSAN</p>	<p>CAR 0B</p> <p>This vehicle warns the spectators and residents that the Competition Cars are about to start. It passes approximately 10 minutes before the first Competition Car and conducts another safety check to ensure residents and spectators are in a safe place.</p>

<p>ICV1</p> <p>www.targawest.com.au</p> <p>NORTHSIDE NISSAN</p>	<p>ICV & MIV CARS 1 to 5</p> <p>These vehicles carry medical and fire-fighting personnel. They may travel at various times along the competition route to attend an incident. They always follow the last rally car through to ensure all crews finish safely. They are also available to attend any resident's emergency by calling the emergency number.</p>
<p>SWEEPER A</p> <p>www.targawest.com.au</p> <p>NORTHSIDE NISSAN</p>	<p>SWEEPER CARS A & B (Green Flashing Light)</p> <p>This vehicle re-opens the road to the public. It travels approximately 15 minutes behind the MIV & provides safety for the officials opening the driveways and roads. No spectator or residents car may have access to the competition route until this car passes.</p> 
<p>Note: Other vehicles involved in Quit Targa West may also be on the Stage either before or after the Challenge and Competition cars. These vehicles may include CAMS Stewards, Chicane teams, Tape & Tag teams, Road crews, Signage teams and other vehicles. These vehicles will be identifiable by door or windscreen stickers with the Quit Targa West logo and a description of their role.</p>
