1. There is new management (2 weeks) in the Shopping Centre that we are working with. Hopefully they will understand what we are all about by Thursday afternoon, but if there are a few hiccups, just be patient while we sort it out.
2. There are no In or Out Controls in the Service Park, but please try and stay in order as this allows the runs to go smoother and less chance of catching the car in front. We will have officials to try and sort the order and to get you moving on time.
3. There are a number of food outlets affected by the road closures and service park, the best thank you we can give them is to support them. Burgers, Pizza, Rolls, Pub Food, Restaurants, Vietnamese, we are sure you will find something to your liking and budget. The Bisto will accept hi-viz and driving suits in their restaurant area.
4. We are working on an area for trailer, there will be no access to the school oval which was used last year. We will let you everyone know. If you can drive your car to the event, that will be a lot easier for all.
5. We will also be able to put a few crews in Main Street and the cark alongside Retail Link.

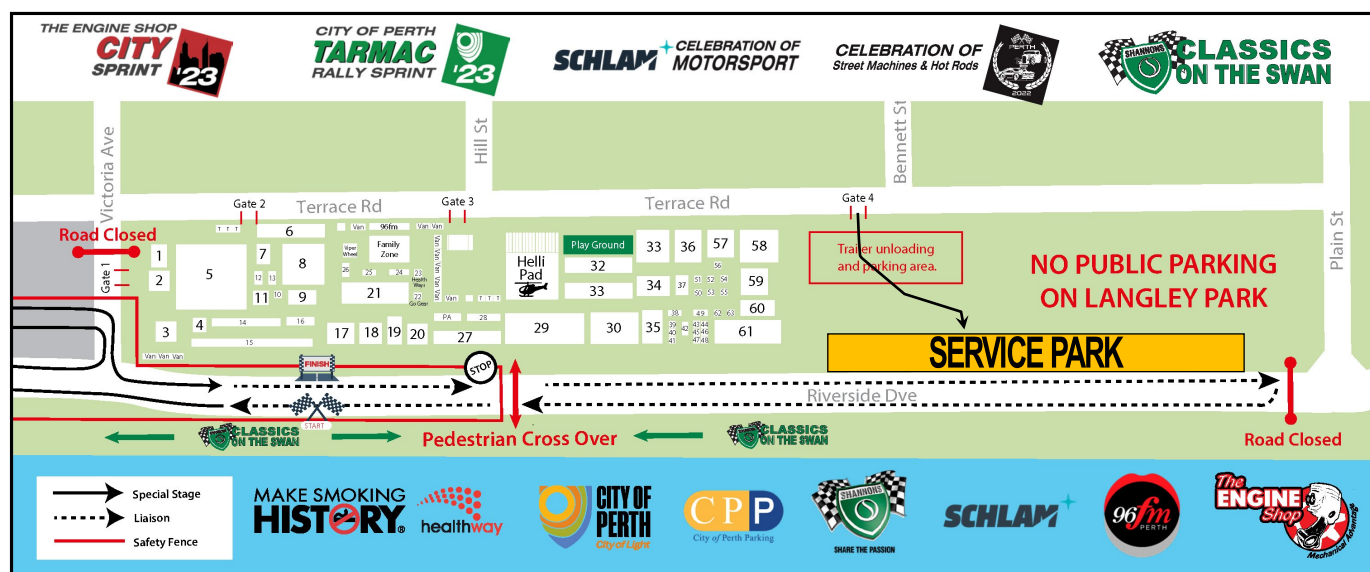




Victoria Road stays open to the public for any businesses that may wish to get to their work, and in particular for spectators going through to internal spectator points. Do not block the road. If setting up in a business driveway or carpark, ensure they will have access to their property if they arrive. Don't leave any rubbish in the area and if working on the car and dropping fluids a tarp under the car must be in place, **under no circumstances allow oil, fuel or fluids to come contact with the ground.**

There are two service stations nearby by for refuelling





1. Only Competition Cars or cars with a Service Crew sticker on their windscreen will be permitted onto Langley Park through Gate 4. Please don't turn up with a list of excuses (Ross said so it will be OK will not work), or even worse abuse the officials. City of Perth are very strict on this requirement.
2. The Engine Shop City Sprint will be using the same area and they may be still running up until midday.
3. Service Crews are to enter through Gate 4. If towing a car, unload just inside the gate and then move to the Service Park.
4. Rally Cars not running at Malaga are to come through Gate 4 and be unloaded off trailers and then go to Service Park, you will be escorted around 2 Riverside Drive after the Drivers Briefing.
5. Rally Cars coming from Malaga are to enter Riverside Drive through Plain Street barriers and to stay in left lane until asked to start the sighting run under convoy. Malaga crews do not need to attend the Drivers Briefing unless pre-told in Malaga due to changing circumstances.
6. Please be ready to do the Sighting Run around 12.30pm, we always lose time trying to round up drivers. I ask each year for a toilet to be down that end, and have failed, I will try harder this year.
7. Note as per the Road Book the entry into the Terrace Road car park is 30m earlier to try and reduce the damage to parking property.
8. After each run the Rally Cars can park on Riverside Drive left lane next to their service crews, always leave the right lane for passing traffic.
